SPIRIT 2

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FOCUS ON: DATA COMPLETENESS

We will use this section of the newsletter to focus on a particular aspect of SPIRIT 2. Let us know what you would like to hear about!

It is essential that SPIRIT 2 has as complete a data set as possible. We need YOU for this!

As many of the secondary endpoints of SPIRIT 2 relate to the cytogenetic and molecular response of patients, this is obviously a key area that we are concentrating on.

As you will know if you have recently had patients going through a 12 month visit (visit 7) we are very keen to follow up to check that bone marrow and PCR data has been collected as per the study schedule as this is crucial for the success of the study, so please expect us to be in touch when the data is due!

Wherever possible, we are trying to get a G Banding result on every patient's bone marrow results. Regulators and reviewers look at G Banding response rates when comparing studies of varying CML treatment options. We need to ensure that the SPIRIT 2 data can provide these adequate comparisons. This is for baseline bone marrow cytogenetics as well as for the annual follow ups at visits 7, 9, 11, 13 and 15. This will ensure that the most is made of the data, and the time that both you and the SPIRIT 2 patients have committed to the study.

You may recall that we recently sent out a survey asking about the access that your site has to G Banding analysis for SPIRIT 2. We would like to thank everyone who was involved in replying to this. We were pleased to see that the vast majority of sites are able to access G Banding analysis, and we would ask you to continue requesting this for all SPIRIT 2 bone marrow analyses wherever possible. If you are having difficulty accessing G Banding analysis, please do get in with us. We will see if there is any way in which we can help.
